This is the daily press release from Valley City Hall, listing important announcements and events:

- The Valley City Council will meet in special session on Tuesday, August 7th beginning at 7:00 p.m. Eastern Time. There will be committee meetings of the budget and finance advisory committee, and public safety advisory committee immediately following the council meeting.
- Work being performed by Mid-South Construction at the former Shawmut Airport hangar is drawing to a close. The City of Lanett intends to erect the structure in their city to house their public works equipment, and has remitted the balance of \$15,000 to the City of Valley to finalize the agreement. The concrete pad remaining where the hangar stood may be developed into a pavilion area at some point in the future, as a special events gathering point.
- The Langdale Park, also known as City Park, and located on 24th Avenue across from the Valley Police Department received a long overdue steam cleaning of the sidewalks, park benches, picnic tables and other equipment. Local vendor Pro-Wash, spent two days at the site to prepare it for the re-painting of the equipment there, and to give it a facelift. The City invites you to visit Langdale Park, which is completely covered by a canopy of trees, has adequate parking, and a base-ball field open to the public.
- A near drowning was prevented at the Valley Community Center on Tuesday when a 32 year old LaGrange woman experienced a medical issue while using the pool. The patron suffered from an unknown condition which caused her to go under water. Another swimmer in the pool and Valley lifeguards brought the victim poolside, and Valley E.M.S. responded. The woman was subsequently transported via ambulance to G.H. Lanier Hospital where she was stabilized and later released.
- Payments for trash service may be made anytime at the outside “drop box” located at the main entrance to Valley City Hall.
